Call for 2020 Applications

Kenya Norway Mobility (KENOMO) (<http://kenomosite.com/>) Project is pleased to issue a call for applications for **one semester study scholarship at university of Stavanger(UiS), Norway.**

The scholarship is funded by Norwegian Government through Norwegian Partnership (NORPART) Programme for Global Academic Cooperation and administered by DIKU.

The programme supports academic partnerships and student mobility with an emphasis on master's and PhD levels in partner institutions.

Partner institutions of KENOMO Project are KCA University, University of Stavanger, University of Nairobi and Link industry with academia (LIWA) trust.

The minimum requirements for Masters level are as follows:

1. Second class honours (Upper division) in any computing degree.
2. Masters or PhD students registered at KCA University or at University of Nairobi
3. Second class honours (lower division) in any computing degree with at least two years' experience as a programmer
4. Grade B and above in majority of programming units.

The minimum requirements for PhD students are as follows:

1. Registered PhD students registered at KCA University or at University of Nairobi.
2. Research Proposal document
